

## JULY 25th

### Saint James, Apostle



Saint James, also known as the Apostle James or James the Greater was one of Jesus Christ's 12 disciples. Along with his brother John and the Apostle Peter, James was a member of Jesus's inner circle, and he witnessed major events the other disciples weren't present for (such as the Transfiguration). He was leader of the Jerusalem Christians, who with Saints Peter and John the Evangelist is one of "the Pillars of the Church". James

was the only apostle whose martyrdom is recorded in the New Testament.

**O glorious Apostle, Saint James**, who by reason of thy fervent and generous heart was chosen by Jesus to be witness of His glory on Mount Tabor, and of His agony in Gethsemane; thou, whose very name is a symbol of warfare and victory: obtain for us strength and consolation in the unending warfare of this life, that, having constantly and generously followed Jesus, we may be victors in the strife and deserve to receive the victor's crown in heaven.



**God's Job — Not Ours**

Perhaps there were some overzealous "weeder" in Matthew's congregation who wanted to purify the community by rooting out the bad seed. Jesus' parable makes clear that any attempt to root out the weeds will only do more damage to the crop. This has played out far too many times in congregations and denominations, with some determined to root out anyone who does not agree with the "right" interpretation of Scripture, liturgical practice, or stand on a particular issue or who pronounce judgment on people outside the church — on people of other faiths. This does serious damage to the church and its mission. Jesus makes clear that we simply cannot be certain who is "in" or who is "out." In fact, God's judgment about these matters will take many by surprise (7:21-23; 8:11-12; 21:31-32; 25:31-46). Thank God it is not up to us! We can leave the weeding to the angels, and get on with the mission Jesus has given us — proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God drawing near.



The Parable of The Weeds

**Matthew 13:24-43 or 13:24-30**

Tal vez había algunos "desmalezadores" demasiado entusiastas en la congregación de Mateo que querían purificar la comunidad arrancando de raíz la mala semilla. La parábola de Jesús deja en claro que cualquier intento de arrancar la mala hierba solo hará más daño a la cosecha. Esto ha sucedido demasiadas veces en congregaciones y denominaciones, con algunos decididos a erradicar a cualquiera que no esté de acuerdo con la interpretación "correcta" de las Escrituras, la práctica litúrgica, o que se posicione sobre un tema en particular o que pronuncie juicio sobre personas fuera del ámbito. iglesia — en personas de otras religiones. Esto hace un daño serio a la iglesia y su misión. Jesús deja en claro que simplemente no podemos estar seguros de quién está "adentro" o quién está "afuera". De hecho, el juicio de Dios sobre estos asuntos tomará a muchos por sorpresa (7:21-23; 8:11-12; 21:31-32; 25:31-46). ¡Gracias a Dios que no depende de nosotros! Podemos dejar la desyerba a los ángeles y continuar con la misión que Jesús nos ha dado: proclamar las buenas nuevas del reino de Dios que se acerca.
