


August 5th The Dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, BVM

First raised at the order of Pope Liberius in the mid-fourth century, the Liberian basilica was rebuilt by Pope Sixtus III shortly after the Council of Ephesus affirmed Mary's title as Mother of God in 431. Rededicated at that time to the Mother of God, St. Mary Major is the largest church in the world honoring God through Mary. Mary Major is one of the four Roman basilicas known as patriarchal churches in memory of the first centers of the Church. St. John Lateran represents Rome, the See of Peter; St. Paul Outside the Walls, the See of Alexandria, allegedly the see presided over by Mark; St. Peter's, the See of Constantinople; and St. Mary's, the See of Antioch, where Mary is supposed to have spent most of her later life.



The Value of the Kingdom

Jesus never explicitly says what the kingdom of heaven is, but he spent an enormous amount of time in his preaching ministry describing what it is like. The image here is striking and conveys that there is nothing more important for a man or woman than to discover this treasure, and then trade it. To be in anyone's kingdom is to come under their rule and reign, their lordship. One cannot be loyal to two kingdoms, especially if those two kingdoms are opposed to one another. It is joy that should drive us to sell all we have to buy that field. Occasionally, the joy is lost on someone who buys the field out of rationality. Their joy is sometimes hidden at first under layers of brokenness and baggage, but as God begins to heal them and show his glory and his desire to bless them, they discover their joy in God more and more. As they learn to walk in freedom, only in hindsight can they see that they sacrificed nothing valuable for the sake of that treasure. They have been far outgiven by God. Jesus is worth trading all that we have and are to become all that he has created us to be. The only way to know what that is to sell everything we have, our current way of life, and follow him with our whole heart, turning over our lives to our new king.



Matthew 13:44-52

Jesús nunca dice explícitamente qué es el reino de los cielos, pero pasó una enorme cantidad de tiempo en su ministerio de predicación describiendo cómo es. La imagen aquí es llamativa y transmite que no hay nada más importante para un hombre o una mujer que descubrir este tesoro y luego intercambiarlo. Estar en el reino de alguien es estar bajo su dominio y reinado, su señorío. Uno no puede ser leal a dos reinos, especialmente si esos dos reinos son opuestos entre sí. Es la alegría la que nos debe impulsar a vender todo lo que tenemos para comprar ese campo. Ocasionalmente, la alegría se pierde en alguien que compra el campo por racionalidad. Su gozo a veces está escondido al principio bajo capas de quebrantamiento y equipaje, pero a medida que Dios comienza a sanarlos y mostrar su gloria y su deseo de bendecirlos, descubren más y más su gozo en Dios. A medida que aprenden a caminar en libertad, solo en retrospectiva pueden ver que no sacrificaron nada valioso por el bien de ese tesoro. Dios los ha superado con creces. Jesús vale la pena cambiar todo lo que tenemos y somos para convertirnos en todo lo que él nos ha creado para ser. La única forma de saber qué es eso es vender todo lo que tenemos, nuestra forma de vida actual, y seguirlo con todo nuestro corazón, entregando nuestras vidas a nuestro nuevo rey.
