

St. Rose of Lime, Virgin

Born into a noble family, Rosa was drawn to penitential practices and a spiritual life at a young age. Her mother wanted her to marry and initially refused to allow her daughter to pursue religious life. To deter suitors, the struggle between them lasted 10 years. Rosa made a perpetual vow of virginity, taking St. Catherine of Siena as her model. In 1606 her mother allowed Rosa to become a Dominican of the third order, but did not permit her to live in a convent. So Rosa chose strict enclosure and contemplation and withdrew to the seclusion of a hut in the family garden, where she endured a life of severe austerity and asceticism. She regularly wore a crown of thorns, practiced fasting and experienced numerous visions. Though a recluse, Rosa was devoted to the sick and hungry in her community and often brought them to her hut to care for them. She was skilled in needlework and sold her fine lace and embroidery and the flowers that she grew in her garden to help her family and to raise funds for the poor. Her funeral was an occasion of public honor. Many miracles were said to have occurred after her death. She was beatified in 1668 by Pope Clement IX and declared patron of Lima; she was canonized by Pope Clement X, who proclaimed her patron saint of South America, the Indies, and the Philippines.



AN EXCEPTION FOR EXCEPTIONAL FAITH


The lessons we can learn from the Canaanite woman have to do with remaining persistent in faith no matter what others think and finally, that God is in the business of helping us grow in faith. The woman from Canaan was outstanding because of the qualities and traits we see as she approaches Jesus. This woman was humble, persistent, emotionally intelligent and trusting. Pride can stand in the way of our worship and our needs, but, her desperate need caused her to put away her pride. People don't always understand what you're going through. So too in life people do not always understand the burden you might be feeling over a particular situation. God does, and His ears are always open to petitions and intercessions. God meets you where you are in your faith and then helps you grow. Jesus' talk with the Canaanite woman helped her to see him as more than just a magician. She saw him as God and was not at the same place in her faith by the end of the encounter. God will sometimes test your courage and faith. Jesus tried to discourage the faith of the Canaanite woman. She could have received Jesus words as an insult and stormed away. But she did not. God responds to persistent prayers of faith. If you learn nothing else from her story, learn this, "Never ever stop praying". Jesus honored her persistent prayer of faith.



MATTHEW 15:21-28

Las lecciones que podemos aprender de la mujer cananea tienen que ver con permanecer persistentes en la fe sin importar lo que piensen los demás y, finalmente, que Dios está en el negocio de ayudarnos a crecer en la fe. La mujer de Canaán se destacó por las cualidades y rasgos que vemos cuando se acerca a Jesús. Esta mujer era humilde, persistente, emocionalmente inteligente y confiada. El orgullo puede interponerse en el camino de nuestra adoración y nuestras necesidades, pero su necesidad desesperada hizo que ella dejara de lado su orgullo. La gente no siempre entiende por lo que estás pasando. Así también en la vida las personas no siempre entienden la carga que podrías estar sintiendo por una situación particular. Dios lo hace, y Sus oídos siempre están abiertos a las peticiones e intercesiones. Dios te encuentra donde estás en tu fe y luego te ayuda a crecer. La conversación de Jesús con la mujer cananea la ayudó a verlo como algo más que un simple mago. Ella lo vio como Dios y no estaba en el mismo lugar en su fe al final del encuentro. Dios a veces pondrá a prueba tu valor y tu fe. Jesús trató de desalentar la fe de la mujer cananea. Ella podría haber recibido las palabras de Jesús como un insulto y haberse ido. Pero ella no lo hizo. Dios responde a las oraciones persistentes de fe. Si no aprende nada más de su historia, aprenda esto: "Nunca dejes de orar". Jesús honró su persistente oración de fe.
