October 24th

Saint Anthony Mary Claret, Bishop



(December 23, 1807-October 24, 1870)

This "spiritual father of Cuba" was a missionary, religious founder, social reformer, queen's chaplain, writer and publisher, archbishop, and refugee. He was a Spaniard whose work took him to the Canary Islands, Cuba, Madrid, Paris, and to the First Vatican Council.

Anthony's vocation to the Priesthood became evident at a very tender age, however financial circumstances made it necessary for him to work in his father's weavers shop until he entered the seminary and was raised in the Holy Priesthood on June 13, 1835. Everywhere he went miracles of conversion were recorded and people sought him out for spiritual help and relief of physical ills. Aware of his dynamism, he was consecrated and appointed Archbishop to the vacant See of Santiago Cuba in 1850, taking with him the motto, "The Charity of Christ urgeth us on", and adding the Mary to his. One of his first official acts was to consecrate his diocese to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. He instituted a Seminary clergy, founded an order of teaching Sisters, and published a simple illustrated catechism for teaching religion which was later approved by the Vatican Council for the entire Church. In 1857 he was appointed the confessor and spiritual director for Queen Elizabeth II and the Royal Household. During this period forces of religion unleashed bitter attacks upon the Holy Archbishop and all he stood for forcing him into exile. From his exile in Parish, the Archbishop traveled to Rome for the Vatican Council, at which he took a very active part. While in Rome Archbishop Anthony Mary Claret suffered a stroke, was moved back to France and died on October 24, 1870

KINGS AND COINS

MATTHEW 22:15-21

**To give
to God
what belongs
to God
is to share
the goods of
the earth!**

In first-century Palestine, taxes were a painful reminder that God's people were living under the oppressive rule of a foreign power. So when the Pharisees "plotted how they might entrap Jesus in speech", the hot-button topic of taxation seemed like a clever strategy. If Jesus supported paying taxes, he would come across as disloyal to the Jews. If he opposed it, he could be accused of rebelling against Rome.

Jesus' reply makes an important point for both first-century Jews and for us today: we can, and should, meet both our civic and religious obligations. What "belongs to Caesar"? In other words, what are our civic duties? According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, "It is the duty of citizens to contribute...to the good of society in a spirit of truth, justice, solidarity, and freedom (2239). This includes a moral obligation "to pay taxes, to exercise the right to vote, and to defend one's country (2240).

What about our religious obligations? What exactly "belongs to God"? Our entire selves! Regardless of nationality or citizenship, we are all made in the image of the living God. So while we pay our taxes and cast our vote to fulfill our political obligations, we give to God what belongs to Him—and that involves the surrender of our entire lives.

Participating wholeheartedly at Mass is a wonderful way to offer to God what belongs to Him. Today, as you set aside other activities to listen to the word of God and receive Jesus in the Eucharist, reflect on what He has given you. Then invite Him to show you how to surrender to Him even more—of your time, treasure, dreams, and of all the people you hold dear. *"Lord, I entrust my whole life to you."*
