EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

EPIPHANY

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Epiphany. "The Lord and ruler is coming; kingship is his, and government and power." With these words the Church proclaims that today's feast brings to a perfect fulfillment all the purposes of Advent. Epiphany, therefore, marks the liturgical zenith of the Advent-Christmas season.

The Solemnity of the Epiphany is celebrated either on January 6 or, according to the decision of the episcopal conference, on the Sunday between January 2 and January 8.

The feast of the Epiphany, which was kept in the East and in certain Western Churches before being observed in Rome, seems to have been originally a feast of the nativity; January 6, for those churches where it was kept, was the equivalent of Christmas (December 25) in the Roman Church. The feast was introduced at Rome in the second half of the sixth century and became the complement and, so to say, the crown of the Christmas festival.

Epiphany means manifestation. What the Church celebrates today is the manifestation of our Lord to the whole world; after being made known to the shepherds of Bethlehem He is revealed to the Magi who have come from the East to adore Him. Christian tradition has ever seen in the Magi the first fruits of the Gentiles; they lead in their wake all the peoples of the earth, and thus the Epiphany is an affirmation of universal salvation. St. Leo brings out this point admirably in a sermon, read at Matins, in which he shows in the adoration of the Magi the beginnings of Christian faith, the time when the great mass of the heathen sets off to follow the star which summons it to seek its Saviour.

That is the meaning, too, of the wonderful prophecy from Isaias which the liturgy appoints to be read in the first nocturn at Matins and at the Epistle of the Mass. This same thought of universal redemption the Church returns to as she sings, in the antiphon to the Magnificat at 2nd Vespers, applying the words to herself, of the union with Christ typified by the wedding feast at Cana, by the baptism of her children foreshadowed by that of Christ in the waters of the Jordan. Formerly the Epiphany was an additional day for solemn baptisms.



EPIFANÍA

Hoy la Iglesia celebra la solemnidad de la Epifanía. "El Señor y el gobernante vendrán; la realeza es suya, y el gobierno y el poder". Con estas palabras, la Iglesia proclama que la fiesta de hoy lleva a un cumplimiento perfecto de todos los propósitos del Adviento. La epifanía, por lo tanto, marca el cenit litúrgico de la temporada de Adviento-Navidad.

La solemnidad de la Epifanía se celebra el 6 de enero o, según la decisión de la conferencia episcopal, el domingo entre el 2 y el 8 de enero. La fiesta de la Epifanía, que se celebró en el Este y en ciertas Iglesias occidentales antes de ser observada en Roma, parece haber sido originalmente una fiesta de la natividad; El 6 de enero, para aquellas iglesias donde se guardaba, era el equivalente a la Navidad (25 de diciembre) en la Iglesia romana. La fiesta se introdujo en Roma en la segunda mitad del siglo VI y se convirtió en el complemento y, por así decirlo, la corona del festival de Navidad.

Epifanía significa manifestación. Lo que la Iglesia celebra hoy es la manifestación de nuestro Señor al mundo entero; después de ser dado a conocer a los pastores de Belén, se le revela a los Magos que han venido del Este para adorarlo. La tradición cristiana ha visto en los Reyes Magos los primeros frutos de los gentiles; lideran a su paso a todos los pueblos de la tierra, y así la Epifanía es una afirmación de salvación universal. San Leo destaca este punto admirablemente en un sermón, leído en Matins, en el que muestra en la adoración de los Reyes Magos los comienzos de la fe cristiana, el momento en que la gran masa de los paganos se pone en marcha para seguir a la estrella que la convoca. buscar a su Salvador

Ese es también el significado de la maravillosa profecía de Isaías que la liturgia designa para ser leída en la primera noche en Matins y en la Epístola de la Misa. Este mismo pensamiento de redención universal al que la Iglesia regresa mientras canta, en el antifona al Magnificat en las 2das vísperas, aplicando las palabras a sí misma, de la unión con Cristo tipificada por la fiesta de bodas en Caná, por el bautismo de sus hijos presagiado por el de Cristo en las aguas del Jordán. Antiguamente la Epifanía era un día adicional para bautismos solemnes.
