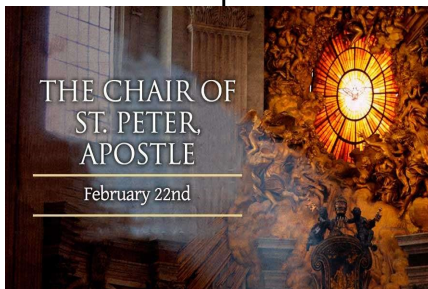

Feast of the Chair of St. Peter, apostle

This feast brings to mind the mission of teacher and pastor conferred by Christ on Peter, and continued in an unbroken line down to the present Pope. We celebrate the unity of the Church, founded upon the Apostle, and renew our assent to the Magisterium of the Roman Pontiff, extended both to truths which are solemnly defined ex cathedra, and to all the acts of the ordinary Magisterium. Since early times, the Roman Church has had a special commemoration of the primatial authority of St. Peter. As witness one of the most renowned of the Apostolic Fathers, the Roman See has always held a peculiar place in the affection and obedience of orthodox believers because of its "presiding in love" and service over all the Churches of God.

"We shall find in the Gospel that Jesus Christ, willing to begin the mystery of unity in His Church, among all His disciples chose twelve; but that, willing to consummate the mystery of unity in the same Church, among the twelve He chose one. He called His disciples, said the Gospel; here are all; and among them He chose twelve. Here is the first separation, and the Apostles chosen. And these are the names of the twelve Apostles: the first, Simon, who is called Peter. [Mt. 10, 1-2] Here, in a second separation, St. Peter is set at the head, and called for that reason by the name of Peter, 'which Jesus Christ,' says St. Mark, 'had given him,' in order to prepare, as you will see, the work which He was proposing to raise all His building on that stone." It was, then, clearly the design of Jesus Christ to put first in one alone, what afterwards He meant to put in several; but the sequence does not reverse the beginning, nor the first lose his place. That first word, Whatsoever you shall bind, said to one alone, has already ranged under his power each one of those to whom shall be said, Whatsoever you shall remit; for the promises of Jesus Christ, as well as His gift, are without repentance; and what is once given indefinitely and universally is irrevocable. Besides, that power given to several carries its restriction in its division, while power given to one alone, and over all, and without exception, carries with it plenitude, and, not having to be divided with any other, it has no bounds save those which its terms convey."



Fiesta de la Cátedra de San Pedro, apóstol

Esta fiesta trae a la mente la misión de maestro y pastor conferida por Cristo a Pedro, y continuó en una línea ininterrumpida hasta el Papa actual. Celebramos la unidad de la Iglesia, fundada sobre el Apóstol, y renovamos nuestro asentimiento al Magisterio del Romano Pontífice, extendido tanto a las verdades que se definen solemnemente como ex cathedra, como a todos los actos del Magisterio ordinario. Desde los primeros tiempos, la Iglesia romana ha tenido una conmemoración especial de la autoridad primordial de San Pedro. Como testigo de uno de los Padres Apostólicos más renombrados, la Sede Romana siempre ha tenido un lugar peculiar en el afecto y la obediencia de los creyentes ortodoxos debido a su "presidencia en el amor" y al servicio sobre todas las Iglesias de Dios.

"Encontraremos en el Evangelio que Jesucristo, dispuesto a comenzar el misterio de la unidad en su Iglesia, entre todos sus discípulos eligió doce; pero que, dispuesto a consumir el misterio de la unidad en la misma Iglesia, entre los doce escogió uno. Llamó a sus discípulos, dijo el Evangelio; aquí están todos; y entre ellos eligió a doce. Aquí está la primera separación, y los apóstoles elegidos. Y estos son los nombres de los doce apóstoles: el primero, Simón, a quien se llama Pedro. [Mt. 10, 1-2] Aquí, en una segunda separación, San Pedro se pone a la cabeza, y se llama por eso por el nombre de Pedro, "que Jesucristo", dice San Marcos, "le había dado 'para preparar, como verá, la obra que estaba proponiendo levantar todo su edificio sobre esa piedra ". Era, entonces, claramente el diseño de Jesucristo para poner primero en uno solo, lo que después quiso poner varios; pero la secuencia no invierte el comienzo, ni el primero pierde su lugar. La primera palabra, todo lo que atarás, dicho a uno solo, ya ha puesto bajo su poder a cada uno de aquellos a quienes se dirá: Todo lo que remitas; porque las promesas de Jesucristo, así como su don, no tienen arrepentimiento; y lo que una vez se da de manera indefinida y universal es irrevocable. Además, ese poder otorgado a varios conlleva su restricción en su división, mientras que el poder otorgado a uno solo, y sobre todo, y sin excepción, conlleva plenitud y, al no tener que dividirse con ningún otro, no tiene límites salvo aquellos que sus términos transmiten".
