The Story of Our Lady of Lourdes

On December 8, 1854, Pope Pius IX proclaimed the dogma of the Immaculate Conception in the apostolic constitution Ineffabilis Deus. A little more than three years later, on February 11, 1858, a young lady appeared to Bernadette Soubirous. This began a series of visions. During the apparition on March 25, the lady identified herself with the words: "I am the Immaculate Conception."

During interrogations Bernadette gave an account of what she saw. It was "something white in the shape of a girl." It was "a pretty young girl with a rosary over her arm." The humble virgin appeared to a humble girl and treated her with dignity.

Through that humble girl, Mary revitalized and continues to revitalize the faith of millions of people. People began to flock to Lourdes from other parts of France and from all over the world. In 1862 Church authorities confirmed the authenticity of the apparitions and authorized the cult of Our Lady of Lourdes for the diocese. The Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes became worldwide in 1907.

Lourdes has become a place of pilgrimage and healing, but even more of faith. Church authorities have recognized over 60 miraculous cures, although there have probably been many more. To people of faith this is not surprising. It is a continuation of Jesus' healing miracles—now performed at the intercession of his mother. Some would say that the greater miracles are hidden. Many who visit Lourdes return home with renewed faith and a readiness to serve God in their needy brothers and sisters.

There still may be people who doubt the apparitions of Lourdes. Perhaps the best that can be said to them are the words that introduce the film The Song of Bernadette: "For those who believe in God, no explanation is necessary. For those who do not believe, no explanation is possible."



La historia de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes

El 8 de diciembre de 1854, el Papa Pío IX proclamó el dogma de la Inmaculada Concepción en la constitución apostólica Ineffabilis Deus. Poco más de tres años después, el 11 de febrero de 1858, una joven se le apareció a Bernadette Soubirous. Esto comenzó una serie de visiones. Durante la aparición el 25 de marzo, la señora se identificó con las palabras: "Yo soy la Inmaculada Concepción".

Durante los interrogatorios, Bernadette dio cuenta de lo que vio. Era "algo blanco en forma de niña". Era "una niña bonita con un rosario sobre el brazo". La humilde virgen se le apareció a una niña humilde y la trató con dignidad. A través de esa humilde niña, Mary revitalizó y continúa revitalizando la fe de millones de personas. La gente comenzó a acudir a Lourdes desde otras partes de Francia y de todo el mundo.

En 1862, las autoridades de la Iglesia confirmaron la autenticidad de las apariciones y autorizaron el culto de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes para la diócesis. La fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes se hizo mundial en 1907.

Lourdes se ha convertido en un lugar de peregrinación y curación, pero aún más de fe. Las autoridades de la Iglesia han reconocido más de 60 curas milagrosas, aunque probablemente haya habido muchas más. Para las personas de fe, esto no es sorprendente. Es una continuación de los milagros curativos de Jesús, ahora realizados por intercesión de su madre. Algunos dirían que los milagros mayores están ocultos. Muchos de los que visitan Lourdes regresan a sus hogares con una fe renovada y una disposición a servir a Dios en sus hermanos y hermanas necesitados.

Todavía puede haber personas que dudan de las apariciones de Lourdes. Quizás lo mejor que se les puede decir son las palabras que presentan la película La canción de Bernadette: "Para aquellos que creen en Dios, no es necesaria ninguna explicación. Para aquellos que no creen, no hay explicación posible".
