- On April 5, 2020 is Palm Sunday which marks the beginning of the Easter Season.

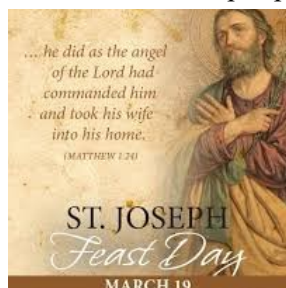
Horário da Quaresma

St. Joseph

Saint Joseph, (flourished in the 1st century AD, Nazareth, Galilee, Palestine region; main feast day, March 19, Feast of Saint Joseph the Worker, May 1), in the New Testament, the earthly father of Jesus and her husband of the Virgin Mary. Saint Joseph is the patron of the universal church in Roman Catholicism, and his life is recorded in the Gospels, especially Matthew and Luke.

Joseph was a descendant of King David's household. After marrying Mary, he found her already pregnant and, "being a righteous man and unwilling to expose her to public disgrace" (Matthew 1:19), he decided to divorce in silence, but an angel told him that son was a son of God and was conceived by the Holy Spirit. Obeying the angel, Joseph took Mary as his wife. After the birth of Jesus in Bethlehem, Judea, where the Holy Family received the Magi, an angel alerted Joseph and Mary to the imminent violence against the boy by King Herod the Great of Judea, after which they fled to Egypt. There, the angel appeared again to Joseph, informing him of Herod's death and instructing him to return to the Holy Land. Avoiding Bethlehem for fear of Herod's successor, Joseph, Mary and Jesus settled in Nazareth (Matthew 2: 22–23) in Galilee, where Joseph taught Jesus his carpentry trade. Joseph was last mentioned in the Gospels when he and Mary frantically searched for the young Jesus lost in Jerusalem, where they found him in the temple (Luke 2: 41–49). Like Mary, Joseph did not understand Jesus' ironic question: "Why were you looking for me? Did you not know that I should be at my father's house?" The circumstances of Joseph's death are unknown, except that he probably died before Jesus' public ministry began and he certainly died before the crucifixion (John 19: 26–27). It was God's will that the Virgin Birth of Our Lord be first firmly impressed in the minds of the faithful. He was later venerated by the great saints of the Middle Ages, Pius IX (1870) declared him patron and protector of the universal family of the Church.



San José

San José, (floreció en el siglo I dC, Nazaret, Galilea, región de Palestina; fiesta principal, 19 de marzo, Fiesta de San José Obrero, 1 de mayo), en el Nuevo Testamento, el padre terrenal de Jesús y su esposo de la Virgen María. San José es el patrón de la iglesia universal en el catolicismo romano, y su vida está registrada en los Evangelios, especialmente en Mateo y Lucas. José era descendiente de la casa del rey David. Después de casarse con Mary, la encontró ya embarazada y, "siendo un hombre justo y no dispuesto a exponerla a la desgracia pública" (Mateo 1:19), decidió divorciarse en silencio, pero un ángel le dijo que ese hijo era hijo de Dios y fue concebido por el Espíritu Santo. Obedeciendo al ángel, José tomó a María como su esposa. Después del nacimiento de Jesús en Belén, Judea, donde la Sagrada Familia recibió a los Magos, un ángel alertó a José y a María sobre la inminente violencia contra el niño por parte del rey Herodes el Grande de Judea, luego de lo cual huyeron a Egipto. Allí, el ángel se apareció nuevamente a José, informándole de la muerte de Herodes e instruyéndole a regresar a Tierra Santa. Evitando a Belén por temor al sucesor de Herodes, José, María y Jesús se establecieron en Nazaret (Mateo 2: 22–23) en Galilea, donde José le enseñó a Jesús su oficio de carpintería. José fue mencionado por última vez en los Evangelios cuando él y María buscaron frenéticamente al joven Jesús perdido en Jerusalén, donde lo encontraron en el templo (Lucas 2: 41-49). Al igual que María, José no entendió la pregunta irónica de Jesús: "¿Por qué me estabas buscando? ¿No sabías que debería estar en la casa de mi padre?". Las circunstancias de la muerte de José son desconocidas, excepto que probablemente murió antes de Jesús "comenzó el ministerio público y ciertamente murió antes de la crucifixión (Juan 19: 26–27). Fue la voluntad de Dios que el nacimiento virginal de Nuestro Señor se imprimiera primero firmemente en las mentes de los fieles. Más tarde fue venerado por los grandes santos de la Edad Media, Pío IX (1870) lo declaró patrón y protector de la familia universal de la Iglesia.
