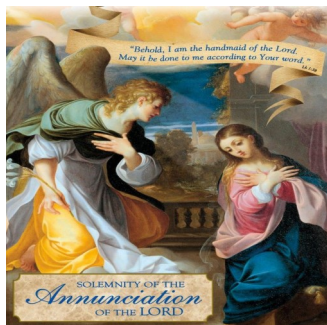

The Annunciation of The Lord

On this day, the Church solemnly celebrates the announcement of the Incarnation of the Son of God. The central theme of this great festival is the Divine Word that assumes our human nature, subjecting itself to time and space. Today is the day when eternity enters time or, as Pope Saint Leo the Great said: "Humility was assumed by majesty; weakness, by strength; mortality, for eternity." With joy we contemplate the mystery of Almighty God, who at the origin of the world creates all things with his Word, however, this time he chooses to depend on the Word of a fragile human being, the Virgin Mary, for to be able to carry out the Incarnation of the Redeemer Son:

"In the sixth month, the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city in Galilee, called Nazareth, to a virgin and said to him: 'Bird, full of grace, the Lord is with you.' Do not fear, Mary, you will conceive and give give birth to a son, and you shall name him Jesus. Mary asked the angel: 'How will this be done, because I don't know a man?' The angel replied, 'The Holy Spirit will descend on you. Then Mary said: 'Here is the handmaid of the Lord. Let it be done to me according to your word'"(cf. Lk 1,26-38).



El Anuncio del Señor

En este día, la Iglesia celebra solemnemente el anuncio de la Encarnación del Hijo de Dios. El tema central de esta gran celebración es el Verbo Divino que asume nuestra naturaleza humana, sometándose al tiempo y al espacio. Hoy es el día en que la eternidad entra en el tiempo o, como dijo el Papa San Leo el Grande: "Se asumió la humildad por majestad; debilidad, por fuerza; mortalidad, para la eternidad." Con alegría contemplamos el misterio de Dios Todopoderoso, quien en el origen del mundo crea todas las cosas con su Palabra, sin embargo, esta vez elige depender de la Palabra de un ser humano frágil, la Virgen María, para poder llevar a cabo la Encarnación del Hijo Redentor:

"En el sexto mes, el ángel Gabriel fue enviado por Dios a una ciudad de Galilea, llamada Nazaret, a una virgen y le dijo: 'Pájaro, lleno de gracia, el Señor está contigo'. No temas, María, concebirás y darás da a luz un hijo, y lo llamarás Jesús. María le preguntó al ángel: "¿Cómo se hará esto, porque no conozco a un hombre?" El ángel respondió: "El Espíritu Santo descenderá sobre ti. Entonces María dijo:

'Aquí está la sierva del Señor. Que se haga a mí según tu palabra'"(cf. Lc 1,26-38).

Announcements

Effective of March 20, the Diocese of Brooklyn has mandated that all Churches remain closed. Thus, St. Pius V will not be open until further notice. This unfortunately includes cancelling all Baptisms, Funerals, Weddings, etc. The office will also be closed, however you can reach the office by phone call everyday (except Sunday) from 9:00AM -11:00AM.

Confessions are still permitted in an outside location and can be set up by appointment. Bishop DiMarzio has granted all the faithful of the Diocese of Brooklyn a dispensation from the law of abstinence for the Fridays of lent for this year. This is being done to assist people who may have difficulties in shopping for food or other reasons which would make this practice difficult at this time.

Masses will continue to be celebrated and can be followed live on our Facebook page everyday at 10:00AM. Intentions will be still be celebrated during these masses and bulletins are still being posted on our bulletins page.

Español

A partir del 20 de marzo, la Diócesis de Brooklyn ordenó que todas las iglesias permanecieran cerradas. Por lo tanto, São Pio V no estará abierto hasta nuevo aviso. Desafortunadamente, esto incluye cancelar todos los bautizos, funerales, bodas, etc. La oficina también estará cerrada, pero sin embargo, puede comunicarse con la oficina todos los días (excepto los domingos), de 9:00 a.m. a 11:00 a.m. Las confesiones todavía se permiten afuera y se pueden configurar con cita previa.

El obispo DiMarzio ha otorgado a todos los fieles de la diócesis de Brooklyn una exención de la ley de abstinencia los viernes de Cuaresma este año. Esto se está haciendo para ayudar a las personas que pueden tener dificultades para comprar alimentos u otras razones que lo dificultarían en este momento.

Las misas continuarán celebrándose y podrán seguirse en vivo en nuestra página de Facebook todos los días a las 10:00. Las intenciones aún se celebrarán durante estas misas y los boletines se seguirán publicando en nuestra página de boletines.
