### Saint Isidore of Seville

The 76 years of Isidore's life were a time of conflict and growth for the Church in Spain. The Visigoths had invaded the land a century and a half earlier, and shortly before Isidore's birth they set up their own capital. They were Arians—Christians who said Christ was not God. Thus, Spain was split in two: One people (Catholic Romans) struggled with another (Arian Goths). Isidore reunited Spain, making it a center of culture and learning. The country served as a teacher and guide for other European countries whose culture was also threatened by barbarian invaders.

Born in Cartagena of a family that included three other sibling saints—Leander, Fulgentius and Florentina—he was educated by his elder brother, whom he succeeded as bishop of Seville.

An amazingly learned man, he was sometimes called "The Schoolmaster of the Middle Ages" because the encyclopedia he wrote was used as a textbook for nine centuries. He required

seminaries to be built in every diocese, wrote a Rule for religious orders, and founded schools that taught every branch of learning. Isidore wrote numerous books, including a dictionary, an encyclopedia, a history of Goths, and a history of the world—beginning with creation! He completed the Mozarabic liturgy, which is still in use in Toledo, Spain. For all these reasons, Isidore has been suggested as patron of the Internet. Several others—including Anthony of Padua—also have been suggested.

He continued his austerities even as he approached age 80. During the last six months of his life, he increased his charities so much that his house was crowded from morning till night with the poor of the countryside.

Our society can well use Isidore's spirit of combining learning and holiness. Loving, understanding and knowledge can heal and bring a broken people back together. We are not barbarians like the invaders of Isidore's Spain. But people who are swamped by riches and overwhelmed by scientific and technological advances can lose much of their understanding love for one another..



### San Isidoro de Sevilla

Los 76 años de la vida de Isidoro fueron una época de conflicto y crecimiento para la Iglesia en España. Los visigodos habían invadido la tierra un siglo y medio antes, y poco antes del nacimiento de Isidoro establecieron su propia capital. Eran arrianos, cristianos que decían que Cristo no era Dios. Así, España se dividió en dos: un pueblo (católicos romanos) luchó con otro (Arian Goths). Isidoro reunió a España, convirtiéndola en un centro de cultura y aprendizaje. El país sirvió como maestro y guía para otros países europeos cuya cultura también estaba amenazada por los invasores bárbaros.

Nacido en Cartagena de una familia que incluía a otros tres santos hermanos: Leander, Fulgentius y Florentina, fue educado por su hermano mayor, a quien sucedió como obispo de Sevilla. Un hombre increíblemente erudito, a veces se le llamaba "El maestro de escuela de la Edad Media" porque la enciclopedia que escribió se usó como libro de texto durante nueve siglos. Exigió que se construyeran seminarios en cada diócesis, escribió una Regla para las órdenes religiosas y fundó escuelas que enseñaban todas las ramas del

aprendizaje. Isidoro escribió numerosos libros, incluido un diccionario, una enciclopedia, una historia de los godos y una historia del mundo, ¡comenzando con la creación! Completó la liturgia mozárabe, que todavía está en uso en Toledo, España.

Por todas estas razones, Isidore ha sido sugerido como mecenas de Internet. También se han sugerido varios otros, incluido Anthony de Padua. Continuó con sus austeridades incluso cuando se acercaba a los 80 años. Durante los últimos seis meses de su vida, aumentó tanto sus obras de caridad que su casa estuvo llena de gente de la mañana a la noche con los pobres del campo. Nuestra sociedad puede utilizar el espíritu de Isidoro de combinar aprendizaje y santidad. El amor, la comprensión y el conocimiento pueden sanar y volver a unir a las personas rotas. No somos bárbaros como los invasores de la

España de Isidoro. Pero las personas que están inundadas de riquezas y abrumadas por los avances científicos y tecnológicos pueden perder gran parte de su comprensión por el amor mutuo.

## Announcements

This is being done to assist people who may have difficulties in shopping for food or other reasons which would make this practice difficult at this time.

Masses will continue to be celebrated and can be followed live on our Facebook page everyday at 10:00AM. Intentions will be still be celebrated during these masses and bulletins are still being posted on our bulletins page.

### Español

A partir del 20 de marzo, la Diócesis de Brooklyn ordenó que todas las iglesias permanecieran cerradas. Por lo tanto, São Pio V no estará abierto hasta nuevo aviso. Desafortunadamente, esto incluye cancelar todos los bautizos, funerales, bodas, etc. La oficina también estará cerrada, pero sin embargo, puede comunicarse con la oficina todos los días (excepto los domingos), de 9:00 a.m. a 11:00 a.m. Las confesiones todavía se permiten afuera y se pueden configurar con cita previa.

El obispo DiMarzio ha otorgado a todos los fieles de la diócesis de Brooklyn una exención de la ley de abstinencia los viernes de Cuaresma este año. Esto se está haciendo para ayudar a las personas que pueden tener dificultades para comprar alimentos u otras razones que lo dificultarían en este momento.

Las misas continuarán celebrándose y podrán seguirse en vivo en nuestra página de Facebook todos los días a las 10:00. Las intenciones aún se celebrarán durante estas misas y los boletines se seguirán publicando en nuestra página de boletines.
