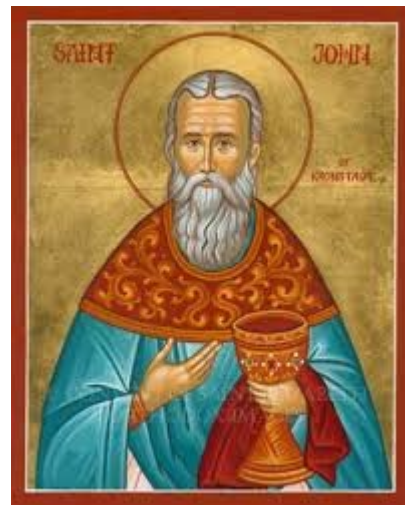
**Saint John I's Story**

Pope John I inherited the Arian heresy, which denied the divinity of Christ. Italy had been ruled for 30 years by an emperor who espoused the heresy, though he treated the empire's Catholics with toleration. His policy changed at about the time the young John was elected pope.

When the eastern emperor began imposing severe measures on the Arians of his area, the western emperor forced John to head a delegation to the East to soften the measures against the heretics. Little is known of the manner or outcome of the negotiations—designed to secure continued toleration of Catholics in the West.

On his way home, John was imprisoned at Ravenna because the emperor had begun to suspect that John's friendship with his eastern rival might lead to a conspiracy against his throne. Shortly after his imprisonment, John died, apparently from the treatment he received in prison.

John's body was transported to Rome and he was buried in the Basilica of St. Peter. We cannot choose the issues for which we have to suffer and perhaps die. John I suffered because of a power-conscious emperor. Jesus suffered because of the suspicions of those who were threatened by his freedom, openness, and powerlessness. "If you find that the world hates you, know it has hated me before you" (John 15:18).



**La historia de San Juan I**

El papa Juan I heredó la herejía arriana, que negaba la divinidad de Cristo. Italia había sido gobernada durante 30 años por un emperador que defendía la herejía, aunque trataba a los católicos del imperio con tolerancia. Su política cambió aproximadamente cuando el joven John fue elegido Papa.

Cuando el emperador oriental comenzó a imponer medidas severas a los arrianos de su área, el emperador occidental obligó a John a encabezar una delegación al este para suavizar las medidas contra los herejes. Poco se sabe de la manera o el resultado de las negociaciones, diseñadas para garantizar la continua tolerancia de los católicos en Occidente.

En su camino a casa, John fue encarcelado en Ravenna porque el emperador había comenzado a sospechar que la amistad de John con su rival oriental podría llevar a una conspiración contra su trono. Poco después de su encarcelamiento, John murió, aparentemente por el trato que recibió en prisión.

El cuerpo de John fue transportado a Roma y fue enterrado en la Basílica de San Pedro.

No podemos elegir los problemas por los que tenemos que sufrir y quizás morir. John I sufrió a causa de un emperador consciente del poder. Jesús sufrió debido a las sospechas de aquellos que estaban amenazados por su libertad, apertura e impotencia. "Si descubres que el mundo te odia, sé que me ha odiado antes que tú" (Juan 15:18).
