Saint Pius V's Story

This is the pope whose job it was to implement the historic Council of Trent. If we think popes had difficulties in implementing Vatican Council II, Pius V had even greater problems after Trent four centuries earlier.

During his papacy (1566-1572), Pius V was faced with the almost overwhelming responsibility of getting a shattered and scattered Church back on its feet. The family of God had been shaken by corruption, by the Reformation, by the constant threat of Turkish invasion, and by the bloody bickering of the young nation-states. In 1545, a previous pope convened the Council of Trent in an attempt to deal with all these pressing problems. Off and on over 18 years, the Fathers of the Church discussed, condemned, affirmed, and decided upon a course of action. The Council closed in 1563.

Pius V was elected in 1566 and charged with the task of implementing the sweeping reforms called for by the Council. He ordered the founding of seminaries for the proper training of priests. He published a new missal, a new breviary, a new catechism, and established the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine classes for the young. Pius zealously enforced legislation against abuses in the Church. He patiently served the sick and the poor by building hospitals, providing food for the hungry, and giving money customarily used for the papal banquets to poor Roman converts. His decision to keep wearing his Dominican habit led to the custom—to this day—of the pope wearing a white cassock.

In striving to reform both Church and state, Pius encountered vehement opposition from England's Queen Elizabeth and the Roman Emperor Maximilian II. Problems in France and in the Netherlands also hindered Pius's hopes for a Europe united against the Turks. Only at the last minute was he able to organize a fleet which won a decisive victory in the Gulf of Lepanto, off Greece, on October 7, 1571.

Pius's ceaseless papal quest for a renewal of the Church was grounded in his personal life as a Dominican friar. He spent long hours with his God in prayer, fasted rigorously, deprived himself of many customary papal luxuries, and faithfully observed the spirit of the Dominican Rule that he had professed.

In their personal lives and in their actions as popes, Saint Pius V and Saint Paul VI both led the family of God in the process of interiorizing and implementing the new birth called for by the Spirit in major Councils. With zeal and patience, Pius and Paul pursued the changes urged by the Council Fathers. Like Pius and Paul, we too are called to constant change of heart and life.



La historia de San Pío V

Este es el papa cuyo trabajo era implementar el histórico Concilio de Trento. Si pensamos que los papas tuvieron dificultades para implementar el Concilio Vaticano II, Pío V tuvo problemas aún mayores después de Trento cuatro siglos antes.

Durante su papado (1566-1572), Pío V se enfrentó con la responsabilidad casi abrumadora de volver a poner en pie a una Iglesia destrozada y dispersa. La familia de Dios había sido sacudida por la corrupción, por la Reforma, por la constante amenaza de la invasión turca y por las sangrientas disputas de los jóvenes estados-nación. En 1545, un papa anterior convocó al Concilio de Trento en un intento de lidiar con todos estos problemas apremiantes. Más de 18 años, los Padres de la Iglesia discutieron, condenaron, afirmaron y decidieron un curso de acción. El Consejo cerró en 1563.

Pío V fue elegido en 1566 y se le encargó la tarea de implementar las reformas radicales solicitadas por el Consejo. Ordenó la fundación de seminarios para la formación adecuada de los sacerdotes. Publicó un nuevo misal, un nuevo breviario, un nuevo catecismo y estableció las clases de la Cofradía de la Doctrina Cristiana para los jóvenes. Pío hizo cumplir celosamente la legislación contra los abusos en la Iglesia. Pacientemente sirvió a los enfermos y a los pobres construyendo hospitales, proporcionando comida para los hambrientos y dando dinero acostumbrado a los banquetes papales a los conversos romanos pobres. Su decisión de seguir usando su hábito dominicano llevó a la costumbre, hasta el día de hoy, de que el papa usara una sotana blanca. Al esforzarse por reformar tanto la Iglesia como el estado, Pío encontró una vehemente oposición de la reina Isabel de Inglaterra y el emperador romano Maximiliano II. Los problemas en Francia y en los Países Bajos también obstaculizaron las esperanzas de Pío de una Europa unida contra los turcos. Solo en el último minuto pudo organizar una flota que obtuvo una victoria decisiva en el Golfo de Lepanto, frente a Grecia, el 7 de octubre de 1571. La incesante búsqueda papal de una renovación de la Iglesia se basó en su vida personal como fraile dominico. Pasó largas horas con su Dios en oración, ayunó rigurosamente, se privó de muchos lujos papales habituales y observó fielmente el espíritu de la regla dominicana que había profesado.

En sus vidas personales y en sus acciones como papas, San Pío V y San Pablo VI lideraron a la familia de Dios en el proceso de interiorización e implementación del nuevo nacimiento solicitado por el Espíritu en los principales Consejos. Con celo y paciencia, Pío y Pablo persiguieron los cambios propuestos por los Padres del Concilio. Al igual que Pío y Pablo, nosotros también estamos llamados a un cambio constante de corazón y vida.
