Saint John the Baptist's Story

Jesus called John the greatest of all those who had preceded him: "I tell you, among those born of women, no one is greater than John...." But John would have agreed completely with what Jesus added: "[Y]et the least in the kingdom of God is greater than he" (Luke 7:28). John spent his time in the desert, an ascetic. He began to announce the coming of the Kingdom, and to call everyone to a fundamental reformation of life. His purpose was to prepare the way for Jesus. His baptism, he said, was for repentance. But one would come who would baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire. John was not worthy even to untie his sandals. His attitude toward Jesus was: "He must increase; I must decrease" (John 3:30). John was humbled to find among the crowd of sinners who came to be baptized the one whom he already knew to be the Messiah. "I need to be baptized by you" (Matthew 3:14b). But Jesus insisted, "Allow it now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness" (Matthew 3:15b). Jesus, true and humble human as well as eternal God, was eager to do what was required of any good Jew. Jesus thus publicly entered the community of those awaiting the Messiah. But making himself part of that community, he made it truly messianic. The greatness of John, his pivotal place in the history of salvation, is seen in the great emphasis Luke gives to the announcement of his birth and the event itself—both made prominently parallel to the same occurrences in the life of Jesus. John attracted countless people to the banks of the Jordan, and it occurred to some people that he might be the Messiah. But he constantly deferred to Jesus, even to sending away some of his followers to become the first disciples of Jesus. Perhaps John's idea of the coming of the Kingdom of God was not being perfectly fulfilled in the public ministry of Jesus. For whatever reason, when he was in prison he sent his disciples to ask Jesus if he was the Messiah. Jesus' answer showed that the Messiah was to be a figure like that of the Suffering Servant in Isaiah. John himself would share in the pattern of messianic suffering, losing his life to the revenge of Herodias. John challenges us Christians to the fundamental attitude of Christianity—total dependence on the Father, in Christ. Except for the Mother of God, no one had a higher function in the unfolding of salvation. Yet the least in the kingdom, Jesus said, is greater than he, for the pure gift that the Father gives. The attractiveness as well as the austerity of John, his fierce courage in denouncing evil—all stem from his fundamental and total placing of his life within the will of God.



La historia de San Juan Bautista

Jesús llamó a Juan el más grande de todos los que lo precedieron: "Te digo, entre los nacidos de mujeres, nadie es más grande que Juan...". Pero Juan habría estado completamente de acuerdo con lo que Jesús agregó: "[Y] et lo menos en el reino de Dios es mayor que él" (Lucas 7:28). John pasó su tiempo en el desierto, un asceta. Comenzó a anunciar la venida del Reino y a llamar a todos a una reforma fundamental de la vida. Su propósito era preparar el camino para Jesús. Su bautismo, dijo, fue por arrepentimiento. Pero vendría alguien que bautizaría con el Espíritu Santo y el fuego. John ni siquiera era digno de desatarse las sandalias. Su actitud hacia Jesús fue: "Debe aumentar; Debo disminuir" (Juan 3:30). John se sintió humilde al encontrar entre la multitud de pecadores que vinieron a bautizarse a quien él ya sabía que era el Mesías. "Necesito ser bautizado por ti" (Mateo 3: 14b). Pero Jesús insistió: "Permítelo ahora, porque así nos conviene cumplir toda justicia" (Mateo 3: 15b). Jesús, verdadero y humilde Dios humano y eterno, estaba ansioso por hacer lo que se requería de cualquier buen judío. Así, Jesús entró públicamente en la comunidad de aquellos que esperaban al Mesías. Pero al hacerse parte de esa comunidad, la hizo verdaderamente mesiánica. La grandeza de Juan, su lugar fundamental en la historia de la salvación, se ve en el gran énfasis que Lucas le da al anuncio de su nacimiento y al evento en sí, ambos hechos prominentemente paralelos a los mismos acontecimientos en la vida de Jesús. John atrajo a innumerables personas a las orillas del Jordán, y se les ocurrió a algunas personas que él podría ser el Mesías. Pero constantemente se refería a Jesús, incluso a enviar a algunos de sus seguidores para convertirse en los primeros discípulos de Jesús. Quizás la idea de Juan de la venida del Reino de Dios no se estaba cumpliendo perfectamente en el ministerio público de Jesús. Por alguna razón, cuando estaba en prisión envió a sus discípulos a preguntarle a Jesús si él era el Mesías. La respuesta de Jesús mostró que el Mesías debía ser una figura como la del Siervo Sufriente en Isaías. El propio John compartiría el patrón del sufrimiento mesiánico, perdiendo su vida por la venganza de Herodías. Juan nos reta a los cristianos a la actitud fundamental del cristianismo: la dependencia total del Padre, en Cristo. Excepto por la Madre de Dios, nadie tenía una función más alta en el desarrollo de la salvación. Sin embargo, lo menos en el reino, dijo Jesús, es más grande que él, por el don puro que el Padre da. El atractivo y la austeridad de John, su feroz coraje al denunciar el mal, todo se deriva de su ubicación fundamental y total de su vida dentro de la voluntad de Dios.
