**Saint Martha's Story**

Martha, Mary, and their brother Lazarus were evidently close friends of Jesus. He came to their home simply as a welcomed guest, rather than as one celebrating the conversion of a sinner like Zacchaeus or one unceremoniously received by a suspicious Pharisee. The sisters feel free to call on Jesus at their brother's death, even though a return to Judea at that time seems almost certain death.

No doubt Martha was an active sort of person. On one occasion, she prepares the meal for Jesus and possibly his fellow guests and forthrightly states the obvious: All hands should pitch in to help with the dinner.

Yet, as biblical scholar Father John McKenzie points out, she need not be rated as an "unrecollected activist." The evangelist is emphasizing what our Lord said on several occasions about the primacy of the spiritual: "...[D]o not worry about your life, what you will eat [or drink], or about your body, what you will wear.... But seek first the kingdom [of God] and his righteousness" (Matthew 6:25b, 33a); "One does not live by bread alone" (Luke 4:4b); "Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for righteousness..." (Matthew 5:6a).

Martha's great glory is her simple and strong statement of faith in Jesus after her brother's death. "Jesus told her, 'I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?' She said to him, 'Yes, Lord. I have come to believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world'" (John 11:25-27).

Scripture commentators point out that in writing his account of the raising of Lazarus, Saint John intends that we should see Martha's words to Mary before Lazarus was raised as a summons that every Christian must obey. In her saying "The teacher is here and is asking for you," Jesus is calling every one of us to resurrection—now in baptismal faith, forever in sharing his victory over death. And all of us, as well as these three friends, are in our own unique way called to special friendship with him.

**La historia de Santa Marta**

Marta, María y su hermano Lázaro eran evidentemente amigos íntimos de Jesús. Llegó a su casa simplemente como un huésped bienvenido, en lugar de celebrar la conversión de un pecador como Zaqueo o alguien que recibió un fariseo sospechoso sin ceremonias. Las hermanas se sienten libres de llamar a Jesús por la muerte de su hermano, a pesar de que un regreso a Judea en ese momento parece una muerte casi segura.

Sin duda, Martha era una persona activa. En una ocasión, ella prepara la comida para Jesús y posiblemente para sus compañeros invitados y declara abiertamente lo obvio: todas las manos deben ayudar a la cena.

Sin embargo, como señala el erudito bíblico Padre John McKenzie, no necesita ser calificada como "activista no recolectada". El evangelista enfatiza lo que nuestro Señor dijo en varias ocasiones sobre la primacía de lo espiritual: "... [D]o no te preocupes por tu vida, lo que comerás [o beberás], o sobre tu cuerpo, lo que llevarás.... Pero busca primero el reino [de Dios] y su justicia "(Mateo 6: 25b, 33a); "Uno no vive solo de pan" (Lucas 4: 4b); "Bienaventurados los que tienen hambre y sed de justicia ..." (Mateo 5: 6a).

La gran gloria de Marta es su simple y fuerte declaración de fe en Jesús después de la muerte de su hermano.

"Jesús le dijo: ' Yo soy la resurrección y la vida; quien crea en mí, incluso si muere, vivirá, y todos los que viven y creen en mí nunca morirán. ¿Crees esto? "Ella le dijo:" Sí, Señor. He llegado a creer que eres el Mesías, el Hijo de Dios, el único que viene al mundo "(Juan 11: 25-27).

Los comentaristas de las Escrituras señalan que al escribir su relato de la resurrección de Lázaro, San Juan tiene la intención de que veamos las palabras de Marta a María antes de

que Lázaro fuera criado como una citación que todo cristiano debe obedecer. Al decir "El maestro está aquí y pregunta por ti", Jesús nos llama a cada uno de nosotros a la resurrección, ahora con fe bautismal, para siempre compartiendo su victoria sobre la muerte. Y todos nosotros, así como estos tres amigos, estamos llamados a una amistad especial con él.

Santa Marta es la patrona de: cocineros, amas de casa, sirvientes, camareros y camareras
