Saint Benedict's Story

It is unfortunate that no contemporary biography was written of a man who has exercised the greatest influence on monasticism in the West. Benedict is well recognized in the later Dialogues of Saint Gregory, but these are sketches to illustrate miraculous elements of his career.

Benedict was born into a distinguished family in central Italy, studied at Rome, and early in life was drawn to monasticism. At first he became a hermit, leaving a depressing world—pagan armies on the march, the Church torn by schism, people suffering from war, morality at a low ebb.

He soon realized that he could not live a hidden life in a small town any better than in a large city, so he withdrew to a cave high in the mountains for three years. Some monks chose Benedict as their leader for a while, but found his strictness not to their taste. Still the shift from hermit to community life had begun for him. He had an idea of gathering various families of monks into one "Grand Monastery" to

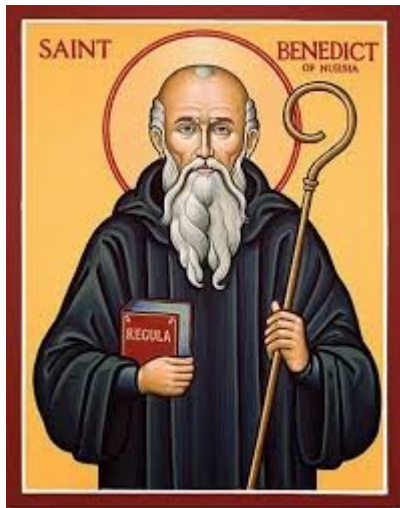
give them the benefit of unity, fraternity, and permanent worship in one house. Finally he began to build what was to become one of the most famous monasteries in the world—Monte Cassino, commanding three narrow valleys running toward the mountains north of Naples.

The Rule that gradually developed prescribed a life of liturgical prayer, study, manual labor, and living together in community under a common abbot. Benedictine asceticism is known for its moderation, and Benedictine charity has always shown concern for the people in

the surrounding countryside. In the course of the Middle Ages, all monasticism in the West was gradually brought under the Rule of St. Benedict.

Today the Benedictine family is represented by two branches: the Benedictine Federation encompassing the men and women of the Order of St. Benedict, and the Cistercians, men and women of the Order of Cistercians of the Strict Observance.

The Church has been blessed through Benedictine devotion to the liturgy, not only in its actual celebration with rich and proper ceremony in the great abbeys, but also through the scholarly studies of many of its members. Liturgy is sometimes confused with guitars or choirs, Latin or Bach. We should be grateful to those who both preserve and adapt the genuine tradition of worship in the Church.



La historia de San Benedicto

Es lamentable que no se haya escrito una biografía contemporánea de un hombre que haya ejercido la mayor influencia sobre el monacato en Occidente.

Benedicto es bien reconocido en los Diálogos posteriores de San Gregorio, pero estos son bocetos para ilustrar elementos milagrosos de su carrera. Benedicto nació en una familia distinguida en el centro de Italia, estudió en Roma, y temprano en la vida se sintió atraído por el monacato. Al principio se convirtió en un ermitaño, dejando un mundo deprimente:

ejércitos paganos en marcha, la Iglesia desgarrada por el cisma, personas que sufren la guerra, moralidad en un punto bajo. Pronto se dio cuenta de que no podía vivir una vida oculta en un pueblo pequeño mejor que en una ciudad grande, por lo que se retiró a una cueva en lo alto de las montañas durante tres años. Algunos monjes eligieron a Benedicto como su líder por un tiempo, pero encontraron que su rigor no era de su agrado. Aún así, el cambio del ermitaño a la vida

comunitaria había comenzado para él. Tenía la idea de reunir a varias familias de monjes en un "Gran Monasterio" para darles el beneficio de la unidad, la fraternidad y la adoración permanente en una casa. Finalmente comenzó a construir lo que se convertiría en uno de los monasterios más famosos del mundo: Monte Cassino, al mando de tres valles estrechos que corren hacia las montañas al norte de Nápoles.

La Regla que se desarrolló gradualmente prescribió una vida de oración litúrgica, estudio, trabajo manual y convivencia en comunidad bajo un abad común. El ascetismo benedictino es conocido por su moderación, y la caridad benedictina siempre ha mostrado preocupación por la gente del campo circundante. En el transcurso de la Edad Media, todo el monasticismo en Occidente fue sometido gradualmente a la Regla de San Benito.

Hoy la familia benedictina está representada por dos ramas: la Federación Benedictina que abarca a los hombres y mujeres de la Orden de San Benito, y los cistercienses, hombres y mujeres de la Orden de los Cistercienses de la estricta observancia.

La Iglesia ha sido bendecida por la devoción benedictina a la liturgia, no solo en su celebración real con una ceremonia rica y apropiada en las grandes abadías, sino también a través de los estudios académicos de muchos de sus miembros. La liturgia a veces se confunde con guitarras o coros, latín o Bach. Debemos agradecer a quienes preservan y adaptan la tradición genuina de adoración en la Iglesia.

Announcements

We have resumed our normal hours of Church and Mass. Therefore, the daily 8:00AM mass will resume as normal, every Thursday, there will be the rosary and Spanish mass at 7:30PM.

Regarding Sunday mass, the Portuguese and English masses will be at the same times. The Spanish mass will be split into two masses, one on Saturday night at 7:30PM and one on Sunday morning at 11:15AM. Groups and activities are still prohibited until further notice. However, there will be an Altagracia rosary on the 2nd Friday of the month.

We are only able to have a 25% capacity of parishioners in the Church, thus once we reach this capacity, we must unfortunately close the doors. For those of you planning on attending the Spanish Sunday mass, please consider attending Saturday night instead of Sunday to avoid being left out of capacity terms.

Reanudaremos nuestras horas normales de Iglesia y Misa. Por lo tanto, la misa diaria de las 8:00 a.m. se reanudará normalmente, todos los jueves 2 habrá el rosario y la misa en español a las 7:30 p.m., y el rosario de Altagracia el segundo viernes del mes.

Con respecto a la misa del domingo, las misa portuguesa y inglesa serán al mismo horario. La misa en español se dividirá en dos misas, una el sábado por la noche a las 7:30 p.m. y otra el domingo por la mañana a las 11:15 a.m.
