**Saint Gregory the Giant**

Saint Gregory the Great was a Roman of noble Christian birth, the son of a canonized Saint, his mother, Saint Silva; and he was the nephew of two others, Saints Tarsilla and Emiliana. At thirty years of age he became the Prefect of Rome, the highest civil dignity of that city. On his father's death in 574 he gave his great wealth to the poor, turned his house on the Caelian Hill into the monastery which now bears his name, and for several years lived as a perfect monk. His famous exposition of the Book of Job dates from his monastic years.

The Pope drew him from his seclusion in 578 to make him one of the seven deacons of Rome; and for seven years he rendered great service to the Church as what we now call Papal Nuncio to the imperial court at Constantinople. He had been sent there to obtain assistance against the Lombard invasions, but returned with a conviction which was a foundation of his later activity, that no help could any longer be obtained from that court. When he was recalled to Rome he became Abbot of his Monastery, then known by the name of Saint Andrew's.

On the death of Pope Pelagius II, Saint Gregory was compelled to take upon himself the government of the Church, and for fourteen years his pontificate was a perfect model of ecclesiastical rule. He healed schisms, revived discipline, and saved Italy by converting the wild Arian Lombards who were laying it waste; he aided in the conversion of the Spanish and French Goths, who also were Arians, and kindled anew in Britain the light of the Faith, which the Anglo-Saxons had extinguished in blood. He set in order the Church's prayers and chant, guided and consoled her pastors with innumerable letters, and preached incessantly, most effectively by his own example. Many of his sermons are still extant and are famous for their constant use of Holy Scripture. His writings are numerous and include fourteen books of his letters.



**San Gregorio el Gigante**

San Gregorio Magno fue un romano de noble cuna cristiana, hijo de un santo canonizado, su madre, santa Silva; y era sobrino de otros dos, los santos Tarsilla y Emiliana. A los treinta años se convirtió en Prefecto de Roma, máxima dignidad civil de esa ciudad. A la muerte de su padre en 574, entregó su gran riqueza a los pobres, convirtió su casa en el monte Celiano en el monasterio que ahora lleva su nombre, y durante varios años vivió como un perfecto monje. Su famosa exposición del Libro de Job data de sus años monásticos.

El Papa lo sacó de su reclusión en 578 para convertirlo en uno de los siete diáconos de Roma; y durante siete años prestó un gran servicio a la Iglesia como lo que ahora llamamos nuncio papal en la corte imperial de

Constantinopla. Lo habían enviado allí para obtener ayuda contra las invasiones lombardas, pero regresó con la convicción, que fue la base de su actividad posterior, de que ya no se podía obtener ayuda de ese tribunal. Cuando fue llamado a Roma, se convirtió en abad de su monasterio, entonces conocido con el nombre de San Andrés. A la muerte del Papa Pelagio II, San Gregorio se vio obligado a

asumir el gobierno de la Iglesia, y durante catorce años su pontificado fue un modelo perfecto de gobierno eclesiástico. Sanó cismas, revivió la disciplina y salvó a Italia convirtiendo a los salvajes lombardos arrianos que la estaban devastando; ayudó en la conversión de los godos españoles y franceses, que también eran arrianos, y volvió a encender en Gran Bretaña la luz de la Fe, que los anglosajones habían extinguido con sangre. Puso en orden las oraciones y los cantos de la Iglesia, guió y consoló a sus pastores con innumerables cartas y predicó incesantemente, de la manera más eficaz con su propio ejemplo.

Muchos de sus sermones aún existen y son famosos por el uso constante de las Sagradas Escrituras. Sus escritos son numerosos e incluyen catorce libros de sus cartas.
