Saints Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael's Story

Angels—messengers from God—appear frequently in Scripture, but only Michael, Gabriel and Raphael are named.

Michael appears in Daniel's vision as "the great prince" who defends Israel against its enemies; in the Book of Revelation, he leads God's armies to final victory over the forces of evil.

Devotion to Michael is the oldest angelic devotion, rising in the East in the fourth century. The Church in the West began to observe a feast honoring Michael and the angels in the fifth century.

Gabriel also makes an appearance in Daniel's visions, announcing Michael's role in God's plan. His best-known

appearance is an encounter with a young Jewish girl named Mary, who consents to bear the Messiah.

Raphael's activity is confined to the Old Testament story of Tobit.

There he appears to guide Tobit's son Tobiah through a series of fantastic

adventures which lead to a threefold happy ending:

Tobiah's marriage to Sarah, the healing of Tobit's blindness, and the restoration of the family fortune.

The memorials of Gabriel and Raphael were added to the Roman calendar in 1921. The 1970 revision of the calendar joined their individual feasts to Michael's.

Each of the archangels performs a different mission in Scripture: Michael protects; Gabriel announces; Raphael guides. Earlier belief that inexplicable events were due to the actions of spiritual beings has given way to a scientific world-view and a different sense of cause and effect. Yet believers still experience God's protection, communication, and guidance in ways which defy description. We cannot dismiss angels too lightly.



La historia de los santos Miguel, Gabriel y Rafael

Los ángeles, mensajeros de Dios, aparecen con frecuencia en las Escrituras, pero solo se nombran a Miguel, Gabriel y Rafael.

Miguel aparece en la visión de Daniel como "el gran príncipe" que defiende a Israel contra sus enemigos; en el Libro de Apocalipsis, él conduce a los ejércitos de Dios a la victoria final sobre las fuerzas del mal. La devoción a Miguel es la devoción angelical más antigua, surgiendo en Oriente en el siglo IV. La Iglesia en Occidente comenzó a observar una fiesta en honor a Miguel y los ángeles en el siglo quinto.

Gabriel también aparece en las visiones de Daniel, anunciando el papel de Michael en el plan de Dios. Su aparición más conocida es un encuentro con una joven judía llamada María, que consiente en dar a luz al Mesías.

La actividad de Rafael se limita a la historia de Tobías en el Antiguo Testamento. Allí parece guiar al hijo de Tobit, Tobías, a través de una serie de aventuras fantásticas que conducen a un triple final feliz: el matrimonio de Tobías con Sarah, la curación de la

ceguera de Tobías y la restauración de la fortuna familiar. Los memoriales de Gabriel y Rafael se agregaron al calendario romano en 1921. La revisión del calendario de 1970 unió sus fiestas individuales a las de Michael.

Cada uno de los arcángeles cumple una misión diferente en las Escrituras: Miguel protege; Gabriel anuncia; Guías de Rafael. La creencia anterior de que los eventos inexplicables se debían a las acciones de seres espirituales ha dado paso a una visión científica del mundo y a un sentido diferente de causa y efecto. Sin embargo, los creyentes aún experimentan la protección, comunicación y guía de Dios de maneras que desafían cualquier descripción. No podemos descartar a los ángeles a la ligera.
