About World Mission Sunday

In 1926, Pope Pius XI established an annual collection for the missionary work of the Church worldwide called "World Mission Sunday." World Mission Sunday, organized by the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, is a day set aside for Catholics worldwide to recommit themselves to the Church's missionary activity through prayer and sacrifice. The Society for the Propagation of the Faith is entrusted with the promotion of World Mission Sunday, collection of the proceeds, and distribution of the proceeds. As a representative of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, the Mission Office in St. Louis sends the proceeds to the National Office of the Pontifical Mission Societies in the United States. Offerings from Catholics in the United States, on World Mission Sunday and throughout the year, are combined with offerings to the Society for the Propagation of the Faith worldwide. Mission dioceses – about 1,111 at this time – receive regular annual assistance from the funds collected. These mission dioceses submit requests to the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples and Pontifical Mission Societies for assistance for needs such as catechetical programs, seminaries, the work of religious communities, communication and transportation needs, and the building of chapels, churches, orphanages, and schools. These needs are matched with the funds gathered in each year. The world's national directors of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith vote on these requests, matching the funds available with the greatest needs. These funds are then distributed in their entirety to mission dioceses throughout the world.

Every year, the needs of the Catholic Church in the missions grow – as new dioceses are formed, as new seminaries are opened because of the growing number of young men hearing Christ's call to follow Him as priests, as areas devastated by war or natural disaster are rebuilt, and as other long-suppressed areas are opening up to hear the message of Christ and His Church. That is why the involvement and commitment of Catholics from around the world is so urgently needed.



Domingo Mundial de las Misiones

En 1926, el Papa Pío XI estableció una colecta anual para la obra misionera de la Iglesia en todo el mundo llamada "Domingo Mundial de las Misiones". El Domingo Mundial de las Misiones, organizado por la Sociedad para la Propagación de la Fe, es un día reservado para que los católicos de todo el mundo vuelvan a comprometerse con la actividad misionera de la Iglesia a través de la oración y el sacrificio. A la Sociedad para la Propagación de la Fe se le confía la promoción del Domingo Mundial de las Misiones, la recaudación de las ganancias y la distribución de las ganancias. Como representante de la Sociedad para la Propagación de la Fe, la Oficina de la Misión en St. Louis envía las ganancias a la Oficina Nacional de las Obras Misionales Pontificias en los Estados Unidos. Las ofrendas de los católicos en los Estados Unidos, el Domingo Mundial de las Misiones y durante todo el año, se combinan con las ofrendas a la Sociedad para la Propagación de la Fe en todo el mundo. Las diócesis de la misión, alrededor de 1,111 en este momento, reciben asistencia anual regular de los fondos recaudados. Estas diócesis misioneras envían solicitudes a la Congregación para la Evangelización de los Pueblos y a las Obras Misionales Pontificias de asistencia para necesidades tales como programas de catequesis, seminarios, el trabajo de comunidades religiosas, necesidades de comunicación y transporte, y la construcción de capillas, iglesias, orfanatos y escuelas. Los directores nacionales mundiales de la Sociedad para la Propagación de la Fe votan estas solicitudes, haciendo coincidir los fondos disponibles con las mayores necesidades. Estos fondos luego se distribuyen en su totalidad a las diócesis misioneras en todo el mundo. Cada año, las necesidades de la Iglesia Católica en las misiones crecen: a medida que se forman nuevas diócesis, a medida que se abren nuevos seminarios debido al creciente número de jóvenes que escuchan el llamado de Cristo a seguirlo como sacerdotes, como áreas devastadas por guerras o desastres naturales. son reconstruidos, y mientras otras áreas reprimidas durante mucho tiempo se abren para escuchar el mensaje de Cristo y Su Iglesia. Por eso se necesita con tanta urgencia la participación y el compromiso de los católicos de todo el mundo.
