Saints Simon and Jude's Story

Jude is so named by Luke and Acts. Matthew and Mark call him Thaddeus. He is not mentioned elsewhere in the Gospels, except of course where all the apostles are mentioned. Scholars hold that he is not the author of the Letter of Jude. Actually, Jude had the same name as Judas Iscariot. Evidently because of the disgrace of that name, it was shortened to "Jude" in English. Simon is mentioned on all four lists of the apostles. On two of them he is called "the Zealot." The Zealots were a Jewish sect that represented an extreme of Jewish nationalism. For them, the messianic promise of the Old Testament meant that the Jews were to be a free and independent nation. God alone was their king, and any payment of taxes to the Romans—the very domination of the Romans—was a blasphemy against God. No doubt some of the Zealots were the spiritual heirs of the Maccabees, carrying on their ideals of religion and independence. But many were the counterparts of modern terrorists. They raided and killed, attacking both foreigners and "collaborating" Jews. They were chiefly responsible for the rebellion against Rome which ended in the destruction of Jerusalem in A.D. 70.

As in the case of all the apostles except for Peter, James and John, we are faced with men who are really unknown, and we are struck by the fact that their holiness is simply taken to be a gift of Christ. He chose some unlikely people: a former Zealot, a former (crooked) tax collector, an impetuous fisherman, two "sons of thunder," and a man named Judas Iscariot.

It is a reminder that we cannot receive too often. Holiness does not depend on human merit, culture, personality, effort, or achievement. It is entirely God's creation and gift. God needs no Zealots to bring about the kingdom by force. Jude, like all the saints, is the saint of the impossible: Only God can create his divine life in human beings. And God wills to do so, for all of us.



La historia de los Santos Simón y Judas

Judas es llamado así por Lucas y Hechos. Mateo y Marcos lo llaman Tadeo. No se lo menciona en ninguna otra parte de los Evangelios, excepto, por supuesto, donde se mencionan todos los apóstoles. Los eruditos sostienen que él no es el autor de la Carta de Judas. En realidad, Judas tenía el mismo nombre que Judas Iscariote. Evidentemente, debido a la desgracia de ese nombre, se redujo a "Jude" en inglés.

Simón se menciona en las cuatro listas de los apóstoles. En dos de ellos se le llama "el Zelote". Los zelotes eran una secta judía que representaba un extremo del nacionalismo judío. Para ellos, la promesa mesiánica del Antiguo Testamento significaba que los judíos serían una nación libre e independiente. Solo Dios era su rey, y cualquier pago de impuestos a los romanos —el dominio mismo de los romanos— era una blasfemia contra Dios. Sin duda, algunos de los zelotes fueron los herederos espirituales de los macabeos, y mantuvieron sus ideales de religión e independencia. Pero muchos eran contrapartes de los terroristas modernos. Allanaron y mataron, atacando tanto a los extranjeros como a los judíos "colaboradores". Ellos fueron los principales responsables de la rebelión contra Roma que terminó con la destrucción de Jerusalén en el año 70 d.C.

Como en el caso de todos los apóstoles, excepto Pedro, Santiago y Juan, nos enfrentamos a hombres realmente desconocidos, y nos sorprende el hecho de que su santidad se tome simplemente como un don de Cristo. Eligió a algunas personas poco probables: un ex fanático, un ex recaudador de impuestos (corrupto), un pescador impetuoso, dos "hijos del trueno" y un hombre llamado Judas Iscariote. Es un recordatorio de que no podemos recibir con demasiada frecuencia. La santidad no depende del mérito, la cultura, la personalidad, el esfuerzo o los logros humanos. Es enteramente creación y don de Dios. Dios no necesita zelotes para lograr el reino por la fuerza. Judas, como todos los santos, es el santo de lo imposible: sólo Dios puede crear su vida divina en los seres humanos. Y Dios quiere hacerlo por todos nosotros.
