Saint Andrew's Story

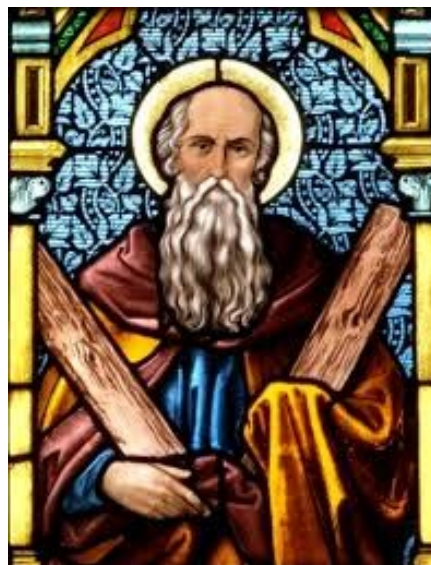
Andrew was Saint Peter's brother, and was called with him. "As [Jesus] was walking by the sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon who is now called Peter, and his brother Andrew, casting a net into the sea; they were fishermen. He said to them, 'Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men.' At once they left their nets and followed him" (Matthew 4:18-20).

John the Evangelist presents Andrew as a disciple of John the Baptist. When Jesus walked by one day, John said, "Behold, the Lamb of God." Andrew and another disciple followed Jesus. "Jesus turned and saw them following him and said to them, 'What are you looking for?' They said to him, 'Rabbi (which translated means Teacher), where are you staying?' He said to them, 'Come, and you will see.' So they went and saw where he was staying, and they stayed with him that day" (John 1:38-39a).

Little else is said about Andrew in the Gospels. Before the multiplication of the loaves, it was Andrew who spoke up about the boy who had the barley loaves and fishes. When the Gentiles went to see Jesus, they came to Philip, but Philip then had recourse to Andrew.

Legend has it that Andrew preached the Good News in what is now modern Greece and Turkey and was crucified at Patras on an X-shaped cross.

As in the case of all the apostles except Peter and John, the Gospels give us little about the holiness of Andrew. He was an apostle. That is enough. He was called personally by Jesus to proclaim the Good News, to heal with Jesus' power and to share his life and death. Holiness today is no different. It is a gift that includes a call to be concerned about the Kingdom, an outgoing attitude that wants nothing more than to share the riches of Christ with all people.



Historia de San Andrés

Andrés era hermano de San Pedro y fue llamado con él. "Mientras caminaba [Jesús] junto al mar de Galilea, vio a dos hermanos, Simón, que ahora se llama Pedro, y su hermano Andrés, que echaban una red al mar; eran pescadores. Él les dijo: "Venid en pos de mí, y os haré pescadores de hombres". Al momento dejaron sus redes y le siguieron "(Mateo 4: 18-20).

Juan el evangelista presenta a Andrés como un discípulo de Juan el Bautista. Cuando Jesús pasó un día, Juan dijo: "He aquí el Cordero de Dios". Andrés y otro discípulo siguieron a Jesús. "Jesús se volvió y vio que lo seguían y les dijo: '¿Qué buscan?'. Ellos le dijeron: 'Rabí (que traducido significa Maestro), ¿dónde se hospedan?'. Él les dijo: 'Venid y ya verás.' Fueron y vieron dónde se hospedaba, y se quedaron con él ese día" (Juan 1: 38-39a).

Poco más se dice sobre Andrés en los Evangelios. Antes de la multiplicación de los panes, fue Andrés quien habló sobre el niño que tenía los panes de cebada y los peces. Cuando los gentiles fueron a ver a Jesús, fueron a Felipe, pero Felipe entonces recurrió a Andrés.

Cuenta la leyenda que Andrés predicó las Buenas Nuevas en lo que hoy es la Grecia y Turquía modernas y fue crucificado en Patras en una cruz en forma de X.

Como en el caso de todos los apóstoles, excepto Pedro y Juan, los evangelios nos dan poco sobre la santidad de Andrés. El era un apóstol. Es suficiente. Jesús lo llamó personalmente para proclamar la Buena Nueva, para sanar con el poder de Jesús y para compartir su vida y muerte. La santidad hoy no es diferente. Es un don que incluye una llamada a preocuparse por el Reino, una actitud extrovertida que no quiere nada más que compartir las riquezas de Cristo con todas las personas.
