Story of the Dedication of St. John Lateran

Most Catholics think of St. Peter's as the pope's main church, but they are wrong. St. John Lateran is the pope's church, the cathedral of the Diocese of Rome where the Bishop of Rome presides.

The first basilica on the site was built in the fourth century when Constantine donated land he had received from the wealthy Lateran family.

That structure and its successors suffered fire, earthquake, and the ravages of war, but the Lateran remained the church where popes were consecrated. In the 14th century when the papacy returned to Rome from Avignon, the church and the adjoining palace were found to be in ruins.

Pope Innocent X commissioned the present structure in 1646. One of Rome's most imposing churches, the Lateran's towering facade is crowned with 15 colossal statues of Christ, John the Baptist, John the Evangelist, and 12 doctors of the Church. Beneath its high altar rest the remains of the small wooden table on which tradition holds Saint Peter himself celebrated Mass.

Unlike the commemorations of other Roman churches, this anniversary is a feast. The dedication of a church is a feast for all its parishioners. In a sense, St. John Lateran is the parish church of all Catholics, because it is the pope's cathedral. This church is the spiritual home of the people who are the Church.



Historia de la Dedicación de San Juan de Letrán

La mayoría de los católicos piensan en San Pedro como la iglesia principal del Papa, pero están equivocados. San Juan de Letrán es la iglesia del Papa, la catedral de la Diócesis de Roma donde preside el Obispo de Roma.

La primera basílica del lugar se construyó en el siglo IV cuando Constantino donó un terreno que había recibido de la rica familia de Letrán. Esa estructura y sus sucesores sufrieron incendios, terremotos y los estragos de la guerra, pero Letrán siguió siendo la iglesia donde se consagraron los papas. En el siglo XIV, cuando el papado regresó a Roma desde Aviñón, la iglesia y el palacio contiguo se encontraron en ruinas.

El Papa Inocencio X encargó la estructura actual en 1646. Una de las iglesias más imponentes de Roma, la imponente fachada de Letrán está coronada con 15 estatuas colosales de Cristo, Juan el Bautista, Juan el Evangelista y 12 doctores de la Iglesia. Debajo de su altar mayor descansan los restos de la pequeña mesa de madera sobre la que, según la tradición, el mismo San Pedro celebró la misa.

A diferencia de las conmemoraciones de otras iglesias romanas, este aniversario es una fiesta. La dedicación de una iglesia es una fiesta para todos sus feligreses. En cierto sentido, San Juan de Letrán es la iglesia parroquial de todos los católicos, porque es la catedral del Papa. Esta iglesia es el hogar espiritual de las personas que son la Iglesia.
