The Story of Mary, Mother of God

Mary's divine motherhood broadens the Christmas spotlight. Mary has an important role to play in the Incarnation of the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity. She consents to God's invitation conveyed by the angel (Luke 1:26-38). Elizabeth proclaims: "Most blessed are you among women and blessed is the fruit of your womb. And how does this happen to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?" (Luke 1:42-43, emphasis added). Mary's role as mother of God places her in a unique position in God's redemptive plan.

Without naming Mary, Paul asserts that "God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law" (Galatians 4:4). Paul's further statement that "God sent the spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying out 'Abba, Father!'" helps us realize that Mary is mother to all the brothers and sisters of Jesus. Some theologians also insist that Mary's motherhood of Jesus is an important element in God's creative plan. God's "first" thought in creating was Jesus. Jesus, the incarnate Word, is the one who could give God perfect love and worship on behalf of all creation. As Jesus was "first" in God's mind, Mary was "second" insofar as she was chosen from all eternity to be his mother.

The precise title "Mother of God" goes back at least to the third or fourth century. In the Greek form Theotokos (God-bearer), it became the touchstone of the Church's teaching about the Incarnation. The Council of Ephesus in 431 insisted that the holy Fathers were right in calling the holy virgin Theotokos. At the end of this particular session, crowds of people marched through the street shouting: "Praised be the Theotokos!" The tradition reaches to our own day. In its chapter on Mary's role in the Church, Vatican II's Dogmatic Constitution on the Church calls Mary "Mother of God" 12 times.

Other themes come together at today's celebration. It is the Octave of Christmas: Our remembrance of Mary's divine motherhood injects a further note of Christmas joy. It is a day of prayer for world peace: Mary is the mother of the Prince of Peace. It is the first day of a new year: Mary continues to bring new life to her children—who are also God's children.



La historia de María, Madre de Dios

La maternidad divina de María amplía el foco de la Navidad. María tiene un papel importante que desempeñar en la Encarnación de la Segunda Persona de la Santísima Trinidad. Ella acepta la invitación de Dios transmitida por el ángel (Lucas 1: 26-38). Isabel proclama: "Bendita tú eres entre las mujeres y bendito el fruto de tu vientre. ¿Y cómo me pasa esto, que la madre de mi Señor venga a mí?" (Lucas 1: 42-43, énfasis agregado). El papel de María como madre de Dios la coloca en una posición única en el plan redentor de Dios.

Sin nombrar a María, Pablo afirma que "Dios envió a su Hijo, nacido de mujer, nacido bajo la ley" (Gálatas 4: 4). La declaración adicional de Pablo de que "Dios envió el espíritu de su Hijo a nuestros corazones, gritando '¡Abba, Padre!'" Nos ayuda a darnos cuenta de que María es la madre de todos los hermanos y hermanas de Jesús.

Algunos teólogos también insisten en que la maternidad de María con Jesús es un elemento importante en el plan creativo de Dios. El "primer" pensamiento de Dios al crear fue Jesús. Jesús, el Verbo encarnado, es el que pudo darle a Dios amor y adoración perfectos en nombre de toda la creación. Como Jesús fue el "primero" en la mente de Dios, María fue el "segundo" en la medida en que fue elegida desde toda la eternidad para ser su madre. El título preciso de "Madre de Dios" se remonta al menos al siglo III o IV. En la forma griega Theotokos (portador de Dios), se convirtió en la piedra de toque de la enseñanza de la Iglesia sobre la Encarnación. El Concilio de Éfeso en 431 insistió en que los santos Padres tenían razón al llamar a la santa virgen Theotokos. Al final de esta sesión en particular, multitudes de personas marcharon por la calle gritando:

"¡Alabado sea la Theotokos!" La tradición llega hasta nuestros días. En su capítulo sobre el papel de María en la Iglesia, la Constitución Dogmática sobre la Iglesia del Vaticano II llama a María "Madre de Dios" 12 veces. Otros temas confluyen en la celebración de hoy. Es la octava de la Navidad: nuestro recuerdo de la maternidad divina de María inyecta una nota más de alegría navideña. Es un día de oración por la paz mundial: María es la madre del Príncipe de la Paz. Es el primer día de un nuevo año: María continúa dando nueva vida a sus hijos, que también son hijos de Dios.
