Saint Mary Magdalene de' Pazzi

Mystical ecstasy is the elevation of the spirit to God in such a way that the person is aware of this union with God while both internal and external senses are detached from the sensible world. Mary Magdalene de' Pazzi was so generously given this special gift of God that she is called the "ecstatic saint." Catherine de' Pazzi was born into a noble family in Florence in 1566. The normal course would have been for her to have married into wealth and enjoyed comfort, but Catherine chose to follow her own path. At 9, she learned to meditate from the family confessor. She made her first Communion at the then-early age of 10, and made a vow of virginity one month later. At 16, Catherine entered the Carmelite convent in Florence because she could receive Communion daily there. Catherine had taken the name Mary Magdalene and had been a novice for a year when she became critically ill. Death seemed near, so her superiors let her make her profession of vows in a private ceremony from a cot in the chapel. Immediately after, Mary Magdalene fell into an ecstasy that lasted about two hours. This was repeated after Communion on the following 40 mornings. These ecstasies were rich experiences of union with God and contained marvelous insights into divine truths. As a safeguard against deception and to preserve the revelations, her confessor asked Mary Magdalene to dictate her experiences to sister secretaries. Over the next six years, five large volumes were filled. The first three books record ecstasies from May of 1584 through Pentecost week the following year. This week was a preparation for a severe five-year trial. The fourth book records that trial and the fifth is a collection of letters concerning reform and renewal. Another book, *Admonitions*, is a collection of her sayings arising from her experiences in the formation of women religious. The extraordinary was ordinary for this saint. She read the thoughts of others and predicted future events. During her lifetime, Mary Magdalene appeared to several persons in distant places and cured a number of sick people. It would be easy to dwell on the ecstasies and pretend that Mary Magdalene only had spiritual highs. This is far from true. It seems that God permitted her this special closeness to prepare her for the five years of desolation that followed when she experienced spiritual dryness. She was plunged into a state of darkness in which she saw nothing but what was horrible in herself and all around her. She had violent temptations and endured great physical suffering. Mary Magdalene de' Pazzi died in 1607 at age 41, and was canonized in 1669. Her liturgical feast is celebrated on May 25.

El éxtasis místico es la elevación del espíritu a Dios de tal manera que la persona es consciente de esta unión con Dios, mientras que los sentidos internos y externos están separados del mundo sensible. María Magdalena de 'Pazzi recibió tan generosamente este regalo especial de Dios que se la llama la "santa extática". Catherine de 'Pazzi nació en una familia noble en Florencia en 1566. Lo normal hubiera sido que se casara con dinero y disfrutara de comodidades, pero Catherine decidió seguir su propio camino. A los 9 años aprendió a meditar del confesor de la familia. Hizo su primera Comunión a la temprana edad de 10 años e hizo un voto de virginidad un mes después. A los 16 años, Catalina entró en el convento de las Carmelitas de Florencia porque allí podía recibir la Comunión todos los días. Catalina había tomado el nombre de María Magdalena y había sido novicia durante un año cuando se enfermó gravemente. La muerte parecía cercana, por lo que sus superiores la dejaron hacer su profesión de votos en una ceremonia privada desde un catre en la capilla. Inmediatamente después, María Magdalena cayó en un éxtasis que duró unas dos horas. Esto se repitió después de la Comunión en las siguientes 40 mañanas. Estos éxtasis fueron ricas experiencias de unión con Dios y contenían maravillosas visiones de las verdades divinas. Como salvaguarda contra el engaño y para preservar las revelaciones, su confesor le pidió a María Magdalena que dictara sus experiencias a las hermanas secretarias. Durante los siguientes seis años, se llenaron cinco grandes volúmenes. Los primeros tres libros registran éxtasis desde mayo de 1584 hasta la semana de Pentecostés del año siguiente. Esta semana fue una preparación para una severa prueba de cinco años. El cuarto libro registra ese juicio y el quinto es una colección de cartas sobre reforma y renovación. Otro libro, *Admonitions*, es una colección de sus dichos que surgen de sus experiencias en la formación de religiosas. Lo extraordinario era ordinario para este santo. Ella leyó los pensamientos de los demás y predijo eventos futuros. Durante su vida, María Magdalena se apareció a varias personas en lugares distantes y curó a varios enfermos. Sería fácil detenerse en los éxtasis y pretender que María Magdalena solo tenía altibajos espirituales. Está lejos de la verdad. Parece que Dios le permitió esta cercanía especial para prepararla para los cinco años de desolación que siguieron cuando experimentó la sequedad espiritual. Estaba sumergida en un estado de oscuridad en el que no veía nada más que lo horrible en ella y en todo lo que la rodeaba. Tuvo violentas tentaciones y soportó un gran sufrimiento físico. María Magdalena de 'Pazzi murió en 1607 a los 41 años y fue canonizada en 1669. Su fiesta litúrgica se celebra el 25 de mayo.
