Saints Joachim and Anne's Story

In the Scriptures, Matthew and Luke furnish a legal family history of Jesus, tracing ancestry to show that Jesus is the culmination of great promises. Not only is his mother's family neglected, we also know nothing factual about them except that they existed. Even the names "Joachim" and "Anne" come from a legendary source written more than a century after Jesus died. The heroism and holiness of these people however, is inferred from the whole family atmosphere around Mary in the Scriptures. Whether we rely on the legends about Mary's childhood or make guesses from the information in the Bible, we see in her a fulfillment of many generations of prayerful persons, herself steeped in the religious traditions of her people. The strong character of Mary in making decisions, her continuous practice of prayer, her devotion to the laws of her faith, her steadiness at moments of crisis, and her devotion to her relatives—all indicate a close-knit, loving family that looked forward to the next generation even while retaining the best of the past. Joachim and Anne—whether these are their real names or not—represent that entire quiet series of generations who faithfully perform their duties, practice their faith, and establish an atmosphere for the coming of the Messiah, but remain obscure.

Reflection
This is the "feast of grandparents." It reminds grandparents of their responsibility to establish a tone for generations to come: They must make the traditions live and offer them as a promise to little children. But the feast has a message for the younger generation as well. It reminds the young that older people's greater perspective, depth of experience, and appreciation of life's profound rhythms are all part of a wisdom not to be taken lightly or ignored.



La historia de los santos Joaquín y Ana

En las Escrituras, Mateo y Lucas proporcionan una historia familiar legal de Jesús, rastreando la ascendencia para mostrar que Jesús es la culminación de grandes promesas. No solo se descuida a la familia de su madre, tampoco sabemos nada de hechos sobre ellos, excepto que existieron. Incluso los nombres "Joaquín" y "Ana" provienen de una fuente legendaria escrita más de un siglo después de la muerte de Jesús. El heroísmo y la santidad de estas personas, sin embargo, se infiere de toda la atmósfera familiar alrededor de María en las Escrituras. Ya sea que confiemos en las leyendas sobre la infancia de María o hagamos conjeturas a partir de la información de la Biblia, vemos en ella el cumplimiento de muchas generaciones de personas orantes, ella misma impregnada de las tradiciones religiosas de su pueblo. El fuerte carácter de María en la toma de decisiones, su práctica continua de la oración, su devoción a las leyes de su fe, su firmeza en momentos de crisis y su devoción a sus parientes, todo indica una familia unida y amorosa que miraba hacia adelante, a la próxima generación, incluso conservando lo mejor del pasado. Joaquín y Ana, sean estos sus nombres reales o no, representan toda esa tranquila serie de generaciones que cumplen fielmente sus deberes, practican su fe y establecen una atmósfera para la venida del Mesías, pero permanecen en la oscuridad.

Reflexión
Esta es la "fiesta de los abuelos". Les recuerda a los abuelos su responsabilidad de establecer un tono para las generaciones venideras: deben hacer vivir las tradiciones y ofrecerlas como una promesa a los niños pequeños. Pero la fiesta también tiene un mensaje para las generaciones más jóvenes. Les recuerda a los jóvenes que la mayor perspectiva, la profundidad de la experiencia y la apreciación de los ritmos profundos de la vida de las personas mayores son parte de una sabiduría que no debe tomarse a la ligera ni ignorarse.
