Saint Bartholomew's Story

In the New Testament, Bartholomew is mentioned only in the lists of the apostles. Some scholars identify him with Nathanael, a man of Cana in Galilee who was summoned to Jesus by Philip. Jesus paid him a great compliment: "Here is a true Israelite. There is no duplicity in him" (John 1:47b). When Nathanael asked how Jesus knew him, Jesus said, "I saw you under the fig tree" (John 1:48b). Whatever amazing revelation this involved, it brought Nathanael to exclaim, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God; you are the King of Israel" (John 1:49b). But Jesus countered with, "Do you believe because I told you that I saw you under the fig tree? You will see greater things than this" (John 1:50b).

Nathanael did see greater things. He was one of those to whom Jesus appeared on the shore of the Sea of Tiberias after his resurrection (see John 21:1-14). They had been fishing all night without success. In the morning, they saw someone standing on the shore though no one knew it was Jesus. He told them to cast their net again, and they made so great a catch that they could not haul the net in. Then John cried out to Peter, "It is the Lord."

When they brought the boat to shore, they found a fire burning, with some fish laid on it and some bread. Jesus asked them to bring some of the fish they had caught, and invited them to come and eat their meal. John relates that although they knew it was Jesus, none of the apostles presumed to inquire who he was. This, John notes, was the third time Jesus appeared to the apostles.

Historia de San Bartolomé

En el Nuevo Testamento, Bartolomé se menciona solo en las listas de los apóstoles. Algunos eruditos lo identifican con Natanael, un hombre de Caná de Galilea que fue llamado a Jesús por Felipe. Jesús le hizo un gran cumplido: "Aquí hay un verdadero israelita. En él no hay duplicidad" (Juan 1: 47b). Cuando Natanael preguntó cómo lo conocía Jesús, Jesús dijo: "Te vi debajo de la higuera" (Juan 1: 48b). Cualquiera que sea la asombrosa revelación que esto implicó, hizo que Natanael exclamara: "Rabí, tú eres el Hijo de Dios; tú eres el Rey de Israel" (Juan 1: 49b). Pero Jesús respondió con: "¿Crees porque te dije que te vi debajo de la higuera? Verás cosas mayores que estas" (Juan 1: 50b).



Natanael vio cosas mayores. Fue uno de aquellos a quienes Jesús se apareció en la orilla del mar de Tiberíades después de su resurrección (ver Juan 21: 1-14). Habían estado pescando toda la noche sin éxito. Por la mañana, vieron a alguien parado en la orilla, aunque nadie sabía que era Jesús. Les dijo que volvieran a echar la red, e hicieron una pesca tan grande que no pudieron tirar la red. Entonces Juan le gritó a Pedro: "Es el Señor".

Cuando llevaron el bote a la orilla, encontraron un fuego encendido, con un poco de pescado y un poco de pan. Jesús les pidió que trajeran algunos de los pescados que habían pescado y los invitó a que fueran a comer. Juan relata que, aunque sabían que era Jesús, ninguno de los apóstoles se atrevió a preguntar quién era. Esta, señala Juan, fue la tercera vez que Jesús se apareció a los apóstoles.
