Saint Gregory the Great's Story

Gregory was the prefect of Rome before he was 30. After five years in office he resigned, founded six monasteries on his Sicilian estate, and became a Benedictine monk in his own home at Rome. Ordained a priest, Gregory became one of the pope's seven deacons, and also served six years in the East as papal representative in Constantinople. He was recalled to become abbot, but at the age of 50 was elected pope by the clergy and people of Rome. Gregory was direct and firm. He removed unworthy priests from office, forbade taking money for many services, emptied the papal treasury to ransom prisoners of the Lombards and to care for persecuted Jews and the victims of plague and famine. He was very concerned about the conversion of England, sending 40 monks from his own monastery. He is known for his reform of the liturgy, and for strengthening respect for doctrine. Whether he was largely responsible for the revision of "Gregorian" chant is disputed. Gregory lived in a time of perpetual strife with invading Lombards and difficult relations with the East. When Rome itself was under attack, he interviewed the Lombard king. His book, Pastoral Care, on the duties and qualities of a bishop, was read for centuries after his death. He described bishops mainly as physicians whose main duties were preaching and the enforcement of discipline. In his own down-to-earth preaching, Gregory was skilled at applying the daily Gospel to the needs of his listeners. Called "the Great," Gregory has been given a place with Augustine, Ambrose, and Jerome, as one of the four key doctors of the Western Church.



An Anglican historian has written: "It is impossible to conceive what would have been the confusion, the lawlessness, the chaotic state of the Middle Ages without the medieval papacy; and of the medieval papacy, the real father is Gregory the Great."

La historia de San Gregorio Magno

Gregorio fue prefecto de Roma antes de los 30 años. Después de cinco años en el cargo, renunció, fundó seis monasterios en su finca siciliana y se convirtió en monje benedictino en su propia casa en Roma. Ordenado sacerdote, Gregorio se convirtió en uno de los siete diáconos del Papa, y también sirvió seis años en Oriente como representante papal en Constantinopla. Fue llamado a ser abad, pero a la edad de 50 años fue elegido Papa por el clero y el pueblo de Roma. Gregory fue directo y firme. Quitó de sus cargos a sacerdotes indignos, prohibió tomar dinero para muchos servicios, vació el tesoro papal para rescatar a los prisioneros de los lombardos y para cuidar de los judíos perseguidos y las víctimas de la peste y el hambre. Estaba muy preocupado por la conversión de Inglaterra, enviando a 40 monjes de su propio monasterio. Es conocido por su reforma de la liturgia y por fortalecer el respeto por la doctrina. Se discute si fue en gran parte responsable de la revisión del canto "gregoriano". Gregory vivió en una época de perpetua lucha con los invasores lombardos y difíciles relaciones con Oriente. Cuando la propia Roma fue atacada, entrevistó al rey lombardo. Su libro, Pastoral Care, sobre los deberes y cualidades de un obispo, se leyó durante siglos después de su muerte. Describió a los obispos principalmente como médicos cuyas principales funciones eran la predicación y la aplicación de la disciplina. En su propia predicación con los pies en la tierra, Gregory tenía la habilidad de aplicar el Evangelio diario a las necesidades de sus oyentes. Llamado "el Grande", a Gregorio se le ha dado un lugar con Agustín, Ambrosio y Jerónimo, como uno de los cuatro doctores clave de la Iglesia Occidental.

Un historiador anglicano ha escrito: "Es imposible concebir lo que hubiera sido la confusión, la anarquía, el estado caótico de la Edad Media sin el papado medieval; y del papado medieval, el verdadero padre es Gregorio el Grande".
